Purpose

The building will be available for the purpose of furthering participation in archery shooting sports and improving the skill level of archers in Nebraska. The focus of our activities will be to introduce more youth to archery, teach safety, encourage development in competitive archery sport participation, and provide hunters a place to prepare/practice.

We will not provide archery equipment (bows & arrows) to use for shooting. Event sponsors renting the building may make equipment available to participants if they have adequate insurance coverage for such activities.

Cottonwood Archery Club Sponsored Activities - Indoor Pricing

Per participant Target Tournaments \$20 adults, \$10 youth (14 and under), \$40 family
Per participant Target League \$6 adult members and \$7 adult for non-members
Per participant Target League \$5 youth members and non-members
Per participant 3-D Tournaments \$20 adults, \$10 youth (14 and under), \$40 family
Per participant 3-D League \$12 adult members and \$15 adult for non-members
Per participant 3-D League \$7 youth members and non-members

** 1st night of shooting is free for non-members.

Other Sponsored Leagues and Events

Participation in leagues and other scheduled events will be subject to **charges** for the respective leagues and/or events **as determined by the sponsors of the respective leagues/events**. League or event sponsors must have a qualified and active Nebraska Field Archery Association (NFAA) instructor, serving as the Range Safety Officer (RSO), on site at all times any shooting activity is occurring – without exception! If you need a qualified active NFAA instructor to serve as an RSO for an event, we can provide a list of individuals acting as independent contractors with whom you may negotiate applicable fees (not to exceed \$25/hour) or donated time as applicable.

Event sponsors will provide a certificate of insurance evidencing liability coverage for events sponsored by them sufficient to protect Archery Solutions LLC from claims arising from use of the building by these sponsors. In addition, event sponsors will be responsible for repairs to building and/or equipment occurring during use beyond normal wear and tear on target butts and/or supplies.

Building Rental Rates to Sponsors (excluding use of target butts, 3-D targets, broadhead target butts, or use of new paper targets that are owned by Archery Solutions LLC):

Open Shooting – Non-Sponsored

To the extent we have scheduled open shooting times, then the building is open to the general public and a qualified NFAA certified instructor will be on duty acting as the Range Safety Officer (RSO) and will be responsible for supervising all shooting activity. Participants are required to follow the directions given by the RSO and for following all of the rules posted in the building.

Pricing for individuals over the age of 14 is as follows:

Target tipped arrow use of target butts use with one paper target per person	\$7/hour pp
Target tipped arrow use of 3-D targets	\$10/hour pp
Broadhead tipped arrow use of broadhead designated target butts	\$15/hour pp

Pricing for individuals 14 years of age and under is as follows:

Target tipped arrow use of target butts use with one paper target per person	\$5/hour pp
Target tipped arrow use of 3-D targets	\$7/hour pp
Broadhead tipped arrow use of broadhead designated target butts	\$15/hour pp

Annual Individual Shooting Pass

In order to meet our insurance requirements, anyone wanting to buy an annual open shooting pass must first be an active status archery instructor certified by the National Field Archery Association (NFAA). An annual individual shooting pass allows an individual a key to the building for use anytime other than during other scheduled events. If the building is in use for leagues or other scheduled events, then an individual may participate, if eligible for the league/event, and must pay the required event fee. An annual individual shooting pass is valid for ONLY the person purchasing the pass and does NOT allow the individual to bring anyone else with them to shoot! The cost for an annual shooting pass is \$1,000 per calendar year, payable in advance, and is not prorated for partial years. The \$1,000 annual fee can be offset by service time teaching and or supervising building activities. The Management Board will approve annually anyone to be given key access. The Management Board reserves the right to decline anyone for any reason.

Annual individual pass holders agree to abide by all of the rules posted in the building and will forfeit privileges if they violate any of the posted rules. Shooting at broadhead designated targets is subject to applicable additional hourly fees, which are charged in order to replace target material from broadhead wear and tear.
